You may serve this Notice and the Motion to Claim Exempt Property by mailing a copy of each, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the judgment debtor. To prove service, you must file an affidavit (notarized by a notary public) with the Clerk asserting that (1) a copy of the notice of rights and Motion to Claim Exempt Property was deposited in the U.S. Mail for mailing by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested; (2) it was in fact received as evidenced by the attached registry receipt or other evidence of delivery; and (3) the genuine receipt or other evidence of delivery is attached. You must attach the U.S. Mail delivery receipt to the affidavit. Alternatively, service of the motion may be effected by any person who is not a party and who is at least 18 years of age following the procedures set forth in Federal Rules of Civil Procedures 4(e)(2). If your attempted service by certified or registered mail or personal service fails, you must file a certificate with the Clerk that the notice and motion to him at his last known address. To prove service, you must file a certificate with the Clerk that the notice and motion were served, indicating why you used such service, the date the notice was mailed and the address to which it was mailed.
